


Breakfast at Everest

Best time to go: September to May.

Arrive in Kathmandu - Day 1

On arrival in Kathmandu you will be met by our representative and taken to their hotel. Sit back, relax, and open up the bottle of champagne that awaits you. If time permits, we will be happy to arrange a short sightseeing and exploring trip. The popular tourist district of Thamel isn't far, and there is a plethora of cuisines to choose from! And of course, we're happy to give our suggestions since we know the area well.

Overnight at hotel. You're on your own for dinner, since we're sure you'll want to go exploring!

The helicopter ride of a lifetime! - Day 2

It's a 5 AM wake-up call to ensure you reach the airport on time - grab the warm gear (we'll advise you on that as well) and make a dash for it. Have a cup of tea or coffee at the airport while we complete the check in and weighing process - the load the helicopter is carrying will need to be correctly assessed to calculate the fuel required. Drive out to the heli for a comprehensive safety briefing. Once in the air the adventure begins!

Over the valley, across the hills to Lukla where the heli lands for a few minutes to dump fuel. And then, back in the air!





Back in the air, fly past Namche Bazaar, Gokyo Lakes, and even over the breakfast stop at Kongde - where there's a table all laid out and waiting!

The majesty of Everest, Lhotse, Ama Dablam, the Khumbu Icefall and other stunning 8000m Himalayan giants will make you cry - how small we really are amidst all this grandeur! Descend to Kongde - where a king's breakfast awaits!

After breakfast the heli flies you to Kathmandu, where this magical experience finally ends. The entire heli trip takes around 4 hours. Return to the hotel and have the afternoon at your leisure.

Spare day for weather - Day 3

If weather played spoil sport yesterday, there's still today to make this exotic trip! In Nepal this is always a possibility and the main reason why a spare day is always a part of the itinerary.

If you've already soared over the Himalaya the day before, head out for some shopping or sight-seeing and then transfer to the international terminal for the late afternoon flight home.

COST INCLUSIONS:

- Accommodation in Kathmandu at the 5 Star hotel, Yak N' Yeti.
- Breakfast on Day 3 at the hotel and breakfast at Kongde Yeti Mountain Home on the scenic flight day.
- Airport transfers for arrival, departure and scenic flight.
- Private charter helicopter scenic flight from Kathmandu, stopping at Kongde only and returning to Kathmandu (defuelling/refuelling stops as required).
- A first aid kit with basic supplies appropriate for the group size - if you require or are taking specific medications it is critical that you discuss this with us prior to your trip departure.
- Down jacket hire.
- Everest permits and registration fees as required.
- All government taxes included.

COST EXCLUSIONS:

- International flights to and from Kathmandu. Services and activities not mentioned in the detailed itinerary.
- Nepal visa fees and international airport taxes.
- Any other gear or equipment that you may need to rent/buy - please ask us if you would like any advice about gear to bring/buy/rent.
- Any excess baggage charges.
- Comprehensive travel insurance that includes trip cancellation and rescue evacuation should this be required for any reason (we require this as the minimum insurance cover).
- Additional nights, optional trips and sightseeing tours outside the detailed itineraries above.
- Single supplement - please ask for single supplement charges if you require them.
- Personal expenses (e.g. mineral water/soft drinks/bar bills, entrance/photography fees at monasteries, laundry, telephone calls, postage, donations, extra snacks etc.)
- Tips for your pilot, city guide, drivers, hotels, restaurants etc (please ask if you would like guidance about appropriate tips).
- Costs incurred due to changes in programs and reservations due to unforeseen events like strikes, fuel shortages, natural forces (e.g. landslides, changes in weather), road blockages, flight/train cancellations and illness etc.
- Unforeseen expenses that demand a change in itinerary
- Medical, Travel, or Evacuation insurance.
- Expenses of a personal nature - laundry, phone calls, beverages.
- Services and activities not mentioned in the detailed itinerary.
